Please do not call for interpretation of the Candidate Manual provided by the CDCA-WREB-CITA. Questions regarding the examination process (e.g., registration, availability, content, paperwork or forms, etc.) should be directed to CDCA-WREB-CITA. **DO NOT contact the school to ask about registering for the exam or for permission to test at their location.** All such questions and requests must be submitted to CDCA-WREB-CITA via [Contact Us](#).

- VISITOR PARKING: There is limited street parking. However, there is a parking lot at the hospital (\$15.00 per day) and there is a parking lot next to the McDonalds on Georgia Avenue (\$10.00 per day)
- SCHOOL USE FEE COLLECTION: All non – Howard University dental student candidates participating in the CDCA-WREB-CITA CIF and Traditional at this site are assessed a \$500.00 facility fee. This is to be paid in Cash. An ATM is available in the lobby of Howard University Hospital or the Barnes and Noble Howard University bookstore across the street on Georgia Avenue. In addition to the facility fee, a check for \$250.00 is required as a refundable security. All fees must be paid in room 326 in the College of Dentistry prior to the beginning of the exam.
- HOOKUPS: Candidates should furnish their own handpieces, instruments and Cavitrons when possible. Handpieces currently used at HUCD are 4-hole, 5-hole, fiber optic (no light), air driven. Must bring motor and handpiece attachment.
- DENTAL UNITS: All of the units are A-dec chairs, lights and delivery systems. Our electric handpieces run by Bien Air Optima MX2.
- RENTALS: There is limited availability for rentals therefore, you must reserve it. Candidates who wish to rent instruments and other items must reserve them by emailing [yolanda.brown@howard.edu](mailto:yolanda.brown@howard.edu). and cc: [breid-bennett@Howard.edu](mailto:breid-bennett@Howard.edu).
- DENTAL UNIT MALFUNCTIONS: Report any equipment malfunctions to the Chief or CFE. A dental equipment repair technician or dispensary staff member will provide assistance as soon as possible.
- INFECTION CONTROL: Masks, gloves and protective eyewear are required. Gowns are not

required but will be provided upon request.

- ❑ SHARPS/AMALGAM DISPOSAL: Sharps containers can be found in each operatory. We utilize the Capt-all amalgam disposal system.
- ❑ COVID-19 PRE-SCREENING INSTRUCTIONS: All Visitors must comply with any HUCD COVID -19 protocols and visitor requirements in place at the time of the of the exam which will be communicated in advance by the school coordinator, Dr. Sonnier [jezelle.sonnier@howard.edu](mailto:jezelle.sonnier@howard.edu).
- ❑ MEDICAL EMERGENCY PROTOCOL: In case of a medical emergency, the candidate should first alert a CFE and/or Chief who will be on the clinic floor. The examiner may inform the coordinator or faculty/staff member from the school. Please call 911 for a medical emergency as well as school security at 202-806-0456 or 202-806-7777. The clinical staff brings the AED, emergency kit, portable oxygen, and pulse oximeter until emergency personnel arrive. These items are located on each floor of the dental school.
