- VISITOR PARKING: Parking instructions such as lot #, parking permit, etc.  
If you are driving your own car, you must contact Dr. Aileen M. Torres at the following email address: [aileen.torres1@upr.edu](mailto:aileen.torres1@upr.edu) to register for parking and follow the next instructions.

Take Las Americas Expressway South (Road 18). Get off at Exit 3 Right (Americo Miranda’s Avenue). Stop at the red light and continue straight. Turn right in front of the Adult University Hospital (“Hospital Universitario de Adultos”). Turn left at the second parking entrance. Identify yourself to the officer and you will be allowed to enter to the Faculty’s Main Parking Building. Once inside, you must register at the building’s entrance with the officer. Go to Office A-149 for assistance.

For uber or cab, instruct your driver to take you to the School of Medicine’s Main Building at the Medical Sciences Campus (“Recinto de Ciencias Medicas”) at the Medical Center premises (“Terrenos de Centro Medico”) located at ‘Barrio Monacillos’. He will drop you off at the building’s curbside location on the first floor (School of Dental Medicine). Go to Office A-149 for assistance.

For the Manikin-Based Examination, take the elevator to the basement. Once out of the elevator, turn left. At the end of the hall turn left again. Then, turn two rights and continue. At the end of the hall to the left you will find the Simulator’s laboratory room (Room BB-48).

- DENTAL UNITS:** All the units are chair type chairs, lights and delivery systems. The manikin exam will take place in the UPR Simulation Lab(BB-48). UPR will provide the shrouds. A light sweater will be handy since the basement is very cold.

- RENTALS:** Equipment and instrument rentals are available for rent for each procedure, except burs, Endo Files and loupes.

- DENTAL UNIT MALFUNCTIONS:** Report any equipment malfunctions to the Chief or CFE. A dental equipment repair technician or dispensary staff member will provide assistance as soon as possible.

- INFECTION CONTROL:** Universal infection control guidelines and Personal Protective Equipment (P.P.E.) and guidelines should be observed during the CDCA-WREB-CITA exam. This includes standard OSHA standards and guidelines.

- COVID-19 PRE-SCREENING INSTRUCTIONS:** Following university and government executive orders, all candidates and staff must furnish a validated copy of his/her Covid-19 vaccine record. If the person is not vaccinated, he/she must present a negative Covid-19 Test (PCR Test) within 3 days of the test date. Do not come to the exam if you are sick.

- There is always a mandatory use of masks for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals throughout the campus as well as social distancing rules.

- MEDICAL EMERGENCY PROTOCOL:** In the case of a medical emergency, notify the examination chief immediately. The chief will notify the college staff person on site who will assess the emergency and notify campus security. If emergency medical personnel are needed the campus security will call paramedics. The college staff person will access any emergency equipment needed, including the emergency medical kit which is located in the clinic.
