Instructions for Outside Candidates and Alumni Testing with the

CDCA-WREB-CITA at New York University College of Dentistry

February 2023 and March 2023 ADEX Exams

Please read this document carefully!!!

1. There is a general facility fee of \$550 for non-NYU candidates. The CDCA-WREB-CITA will collect this facility fee on behalf of NYU. It is paid at the same time with your ADEX exam fees through your CDCA-WREB-CITA account. Instrument rental, which is mandatory, is included in this facility fee but is not paid by alumni. Therefore, alumni are charged \$275.

<u>Payment of this fee does not entitle the outside candidate to use the school facilities to practice or to screen for patients.</u> There will be no opportunity to tour the facilities.

You will be provided with all the same instruments as NYU students. There is no instrument list. The handpieces currently used at NYU are not fiber optic, are 4 holes, and are Star or Midwest brand. You can bring your own if you like, electric or air driven, along with any other personal instruments you like to use.

- 2. Included in the clinic usage fee are all instruments and materials needed for the exam including but not limited to: local and topical anesthetics, needles, gloves, masks, headrest covers, bracket table covers, paper cups, patient towels, gauze, cotton rolls, plaster, stone, waxes, acrylics, and impression and restorative materials. Candidates may provide their own brands of any of the above materials if preferred.
- 3. All Visitors must comply with all NYU COVID-19 protocols and visitor requirements. Effective October 24, 2022, the University will no longer require visitors (including affiliates and vendors) to present proof of vaccination at the point of entry to NYU buildings or University-sponsored events or upload proof of vaccination. Still, all visitors must be prepared to present proof of compliance with the University's COVID-19 vaccination requirements if asked to do so. However, NYU no longer requires proof of a negative PCR test. Please contact
