3. Parking:

There is a public parking lot located on the corner of 5th and Mission Streets, next to the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry which charges by the hour. We do not validate parking.

Street parking is limited to metered parking and the fine for overtime parking is quite expensive.

Directions to the school:

The School of Dentistry is located at 155 5th Street. Entrance to the exam will be on 5th Street, the "Faculty/Staff/Student Entrance". <u>Please do not enter through the patient entrance on 5th and Minna Street.</u>

From the Airport

Take Highway 101 north to San Francisco. Take the Seventh Street exit and make a left onto 7th. Make a right on Folsom to 5th Street, then make a left on 5th St. There is a parking garage on the corner of 5th and Mission.

Food/Lunch Facilities

Please be advised that we <u>do not</u> have food, beverage, or cafeteria services available to candidates during weekends. There are many outside food establishments within walking distance of the school. At the Westfield Shopping mall located at 5th and Mission there is a food court with a variety of eateries available. At the Metreon on 4th and Minna there is also a food court.

Please remember that no food or drink are allowed in the clinical areas or operatories.

University of the Pacific School of Dentistry Facility and Services

1. Building and Access Hours:

The University of the Pacific School of Dentistry building will open from 6:00am on examination days during the exam, unless otherwise requested by CDCA-WREB-CITA. Please note that <u>the day before the examinations begin</u>, the building and campus <u>will be</u> <u>closed to everyone</u> (including tours) for cleaning and pre-examination set-up.

2. Registration and Identification Badges

Numbered badges issued to candidates (by CDCA-WREB-CITA usually at orientation) will serve as your I.D. throughout the examination. The badge must be worn at all times while in the building. Badges <u>must be turned in</u> at the completion of the examination(s) as a part of the checkout procedure with CDCA-WREB-CITA.

Preparing for the Clinical Phase of the Examination

Candidates will be using the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry Simulation Clinic for the exam, located on the 5th floor of the school. Each candidate will be assigned a numbered operatory that corresponds to his or her numbered I.D. badge issued at orientation. Each operatory is equipped with one dental chair, one delivery unit equipped with air/water syringe, and one operator's chair. There is no need to request a left-handed user chair, as our units can be configured for both.

There will be no storage areas available for your equipment in the clinic, you will need to bring and take your equipment with you each day.

Equipment malfunctions: We will have technicians from our Building Operations team available all day if you experience any problems with your equipment.

During the Exam

1. Facility Fee & Instrument Kit Rentals

The facility fee for this exam is \$760, which also includes rental of instruments, handpieces, and use of all dental materials needed for the exam.

Even if you choose to bring your own instruments/materials, you are still responsible for the facility fee, as this covers the school's costs to administer the exam. The instrument rental included in the facility fee is offered as a courtesy to the candidates rather than charging a separate instrument rental fee. 2. CDCA-WREB-CITA will provide all typodonts for the exam

3. Handpiece and Prophy Angle Hookups

We have Kavo and BienAir electric high speed and slow speed handpieces, as well as Star airdriven high and slow speed handpieces.

4. Infection Control/Asepsis Requirements

a. Surface Asepsis

i. The patient chair, dental unit, counter tops, and operator stool should be disinfected with disinfectant wipes provided by the school.

b. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- i. Disposable gowns, nitrile gloves, Level 3 masks, and face shields will be made available to all candidates free of charge.
- ii. Candidates must provide their own loupes or protective eyewear.

c. Sterilization

i. If you choose to bring your own instruments to the exam, the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry does not provide sterilization services for your instruments.
