Driving Directions to the Clinic

- At **EXIT 8**, take ramp for I-15 **St George Boulevard**
- Turn **LEFT** onto UT-34 E / E St George Blvd
- Turn **RIGHT** onto River Rd. You will **pass Target and Lowes** on the left-hand side.
- Turn **LEFT** onto **E Medical Center Drive** / E 480 South
- Pass Intermountain Dixie Regional Medical Center and Jubilee Home II on the right-hand side.
- Turn **RIGHT** into the DSU Taylor Health Sciences Center parking lot.
- Park and enter on the **SOUTHEAST SIDE** at the Dental Hygiene Clinic Entrance.

Parking:

- Enter the Clinic on the South Side of the Taylor Health Science Center
- **Free parking** for Candidates and Patients allowed in any part of the parking lot located at the Russell Taylor Health Science Building.
- Permits are not required during examination days and parking lot hours are 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Vehicles left after hours on campus are subject to being towed.

2. Preparing for the Exams

a. Facility Fee

- The facility fee for Local Anesthesia is \$75.00 and will be collected by CDCA-WREB-CITA at time of online registration.
- The facility fee for Restorative is \$100.00 and will be collected by CDCA-WREB-CITA at time of online registration.

b. Local Anesthesia Exam,

- **Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials:** Refer to the respective Local Anesthesia Candidate Guide for a list of materials and armamentarium that the Candidate must provide.

A. Air/Water Syringe Tips: Syringe tips are disposable and available at no charge.

B. Expendable Materials: Expendable dental materials supplied by the school. (Items not listed are responsibility of Candidate).

c. Restorative Exam

Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials: Refer to the respective Candidate Guide for a list of materials and armamentarium that the Candidate must provide.

A. Curing Lights: Curing lights and shields will be provided at each unit.

B. Air/Water Syringe Tips: Syringe tips are disposable and available at no

charge.

C. Expendable Materials: Expendable dental materials supplied by the school are noted in **Appendix B**.

Sterilization Services: Should candidates require instrument sterilization; an assistant will be available between 4:30pm and 6:30pm to sterilize instruments for the following day's test. Sterilization will not be available following the test. Appropriate containers should be brought with the candidates for carrying out soiled instruments following the examination. **Candidates retaking onsite will need their instruments sterilized prior to retake exam.**

3. During the Clinical Exam

Dental Operatory Units: All operatories are equipped with Belmont chairs, BDS 0020 and delivery control Belmont X-Calibur 2575.

- **Infection Control (Surface Asepsis):**

- Each candidate will be expected to clean her/his operatory area following the examination. Candidates will be given a packet of barriers to reset the area for the following candidate.
- All barriers, eye protection, masks and gloves are required during cleaning tasks.
- Sprays will not be used in the immediate clinic area. Disinfection of clinic surfaces is to be performed using pre-moistened *Sani-cloths* located in the cabinet underneath the sink.
- Please clean up any disclosing solution spills or shoe scuff marks from the floors when cleaning. Cleaning supplies are available upon request.
- All area touched during patient treatment should be barrier wrapped. These areas should also be wiped down with Sani-cloths following the examination.
- **Candidates should arrive with sterile instruments.** In the event candidates need sterilization procedures, an assistant will run the instruments through an ultrasonic pre-cleaning unit, then autoclave them. Instruments will not be sterilized following the examination, so candidates must bring appropriate containers for carrying soiled instruments.
- A biohazard container is located in the sterilization area as you enter the door and to the right. There will be a small white bag with biohazard sticker at each unit for biohazard waste.
- **Restorative:** Amalgam scraps from the catch bag and amalgam well will be dumped out

into the Amalgam scrap jar(s) next to the amalgamator.

- **Local Anesthesia:** Sharps containers are available in each operatory. With protective shield in place, remove needle from syringe and place in a plastic cup. Dump paper cup in sharps container.
- **Sharps Disposal:** Red plastic sharps containers are available in each operatory. All needles, irrigation tips, broken instrument tips, etc. should be safely placed in a paper cup then emptied into the sharps container.
- **Emergency Medical Equipment:** First aid kits are located in the modeling trimming lab and faculty room. An AED is mounted on the wall near the clinic back door hallway. Emergency oxygen tank and emergency kit are in the model trimming lab. An emergency binder is near the oxygen tank. Each operatory has a medical emergency protocols binder mounted above the sink. All DSU phones need to dial an “8” for an outside line. A “911” call script is taped to the wall by each phone in the operatories. Eyewash station is in the sterilization room and model trimming lab. Exposure protocol for needle sticks etc. is in the faculty room. Ask UT personnel for immediate assistance.

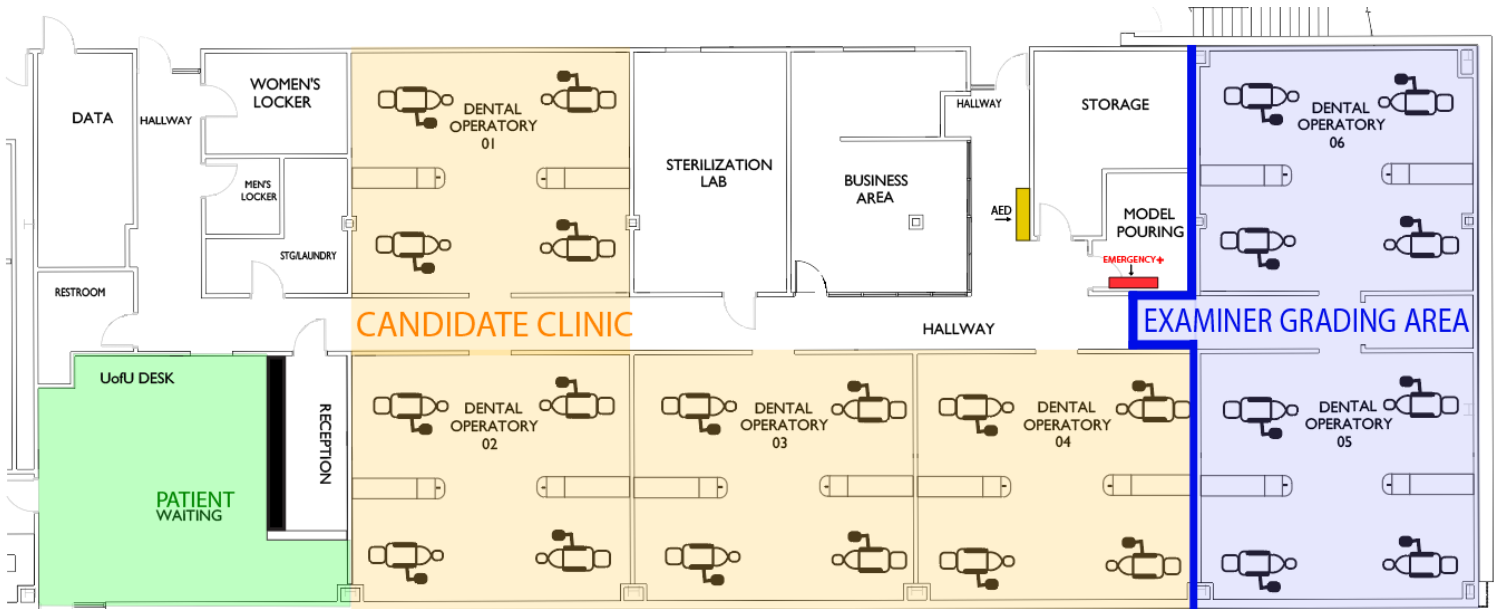
