Bluegrass Community and Technical College Oswald Building Cooper Campus is offering its dental facilities to candidates for the 2023 ADEX, CDCA-WREB-CITA dental hygiene manikin examination which will be held on Friday April 14th and Sat April 15th, 2023. Please read the following very carefully.

Facility Fee:

Candidates will be assessed a fee of \$150.00. This fee will include the use of the facility, equipment, and miscellaneous supplies. The facility fee will be collected upon online registration by CDCA-WREB-CITA.

Parking/Entering the Building:

Free parking is available in the BCTC Green lot. This lot is situated between the Oswald Building and Kroger field (the University of Kentucky football field). Please park in the designated parking spots that are marked by a black rectangular sign that says:" BCTC DH patient parking".

Building Hours:

The building will open @ 7:30 am on Friday, April 14th, 2023, and 6:00 am Saturday, April 15th, 2023.

Finding the Dental Clinic:

Dental Hygiene Clinic, Oswald Building, 1st floor, RM 250 – Signs will be posted! Enter the front doors and come straight in through the lobby to the second hallway on the left. Proceed down that hallway and the clinic will be on the right.

Food and Beverage Services:

Bluegrass Community and Technical College has no food, beverage, or cafeteria services for candidates. Candidates should eat before coming to the exam. There are several gas stations, restaurants and fast-food establishments located within one (1) mile of the campus if you wish to purchase food. However, food or drink are not allowed in any areas near the candidate clinics or check in desk during the examination.

Supplies and Equipment:

Bluegrass Community and Technical College is a latex safe environment and will provide the following equipment:

• Over garments • Nitrile exam gloves (XS, S, M, L, XL) • Ear loop face masks • Surface disinfectant and barriers • Saliva ejectors / HVE disposable tips • Plastic Air/water syringe tips • Pens for writing • 2 x 2 gauze squares • Tray covers • Facial tissue

Bluegrass Community and Technical College will not provide the following:

-Protective eyewear with side shields for the candidate -Face shields if used -Instruments and 30K Ultrasonic inserts -Plastic containers for transporting instruments -Appropriate clinic attire.

NOTE: Please be advised there is not a supply store or an ATM available on the campus here at Bluegrass Community and Technical College

Cavitron units and inserts:

Bluegrass Community and Technical College have a limited number of units and inserts for rent on a first request first come basis. If you need to rent these items, or want more information on the equipment available, please contact Rene' Bosshart by email at rene.bosshart@kctcs.edu

Other Limitations: No instrument sharpening services for dental hygiene instruments are available at Bluegrass Community and Technical College before, during, or after the examination(s). If a candidate experiences a broken tip on one or more of their instruments during the examination BCTC does NOT have replacement instruments to loan/sell to candidates, so please come prepared accordingly.

Personal Protection and Infection Control:

It is the policy of the BCTC Dental Hygiene Department that all candidates wear protective glasses, with side-shields, gloves, and a face mask while performing the examination. Each candidate is responsible for providing protective eyewear with side shields. Overgarments, gloves, and masks will be provided as part of the basic site fee.

Please Note:

Cubicle surfaces and operatory equipment must be cleaned and disinfected with the supplied disinfectant when the exam is completed. All instruments and handpieces must be sterile, please bring them to the examination in appropriate packaging. Sterilization services are not available prior to or after the examination.

Emergency Equipment and Preparedness for Medical Emergency:

In the event of an emergency, the procedure is: • Verbally notify the CDCA-WREB-CITA Floor Assistant, School Coordinator or Chief Examiner of the emergency. • Make sure someone calls the local 9-1-1 (notify EMS). 8 • Administer oxygen (O2) from the green oxygen cylinder located next to the medical emergency kit. • Administer Basic Life Support (BLS) until EMS arrive- there is also a defibrillator located next to the oxygen tank.

Reminder:

As a reminder candidates should not bring cell phones, smart watches, notes, laptops, or PDAs to the examination. Items left behind after a candidate's exam is completed may not be returned.
