4. Gas, Food and ATM's

NO ATM services are available on the SLCC Jordan Campus.

5. SLCC Jordan Campus Parking

A parking map has been included in this candidate guide for your convenience. Parking at the SLCC Jordan Campus is monitored by campus parking services. Digital parking permits will be activated for candidates by providing a photo of your vehicle license plate upon arrival to the dental hygiene reception desk located in HTC 173. **The digital parking permit is valid for Student spaces in parking lot J-2 ONLY**(see map link below).

Candidates and patients may park in the following areas within lot J-2:

Student spaces (designated by yellow painted lines).

* State Issued Handicap Permits are Required for ALL Handicap Spaces

***Do NOT park in "Metered" parking spaces**

***Do NOT park in faculty BLUE lines spaces**

SLCC Jordan Campus Facility and Services

1. Building and Access Hours:

The SLCC Jordan Campus building will open from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on examination days, unless otherwise requested by the CDCA-WREB-CITA. Please note that **the day before the examinations begin**, the building and campus **will be closed to everyone** (including tours) for cleaning and pre-examination set-up.

2. Food and Beverage Services:

- Fresh Seasons Café located in the High-Tech Learning Center East of the Dental Hygiene clinic. They serve a limited menu of breakfast and lunch items, coffee, drinks and ready-made salads. Hours are: 8:00am-3:00pm Mon.-Thurs., Friday 8:00am-2:00pm.
- The Campus Bookstore (Located in the Huval Student Center) has beverages and

snacks available for purchase.

Hours are: 9:00am – 5:00pm Mon. – Thurs., Friday 9:00am-2:00pm, Closed Saturday

- Beverage and snack vending machines are located at the east end of the lobby in the hallway and near the Cafe.
- **Food and drinks are not permitted in the clinical areas**

3. Registration and Identification Badges

Numbered badges issued to candidates (by CDCA-WREB-CITA) will serve as your I.D. throughout the examination. The badge must be worn at all times while in the building. Badges **must be turned in** at the completion of the examination(s) as a part of the checkout procedure with CDCA-WREB-CITA.

Preparing for the Clinical Phase of the Examination

Candidates will be using the SLCC Jordan Campus. Each candidate will be assigned a numbered operatory that corresponds to his or her numbered I.D. badge issued prior to the start of the exam. Each operatory is equipped with one dental chair, one delivery unit equipped with air/water syringe, and one operator's stool. All equipment malfunctions that take place during the examination should be immediately reported to the Chief Examiner.

Emergency Equipment and Preparedness for Medical Emergency

All candidates should familiarize themselves with the location of the oxygen/emergency cart (medical emergency kit) and the first aid kit.

- An emergency medical kit is located in the labeled cabinet of operatory 9.
- Emergency oxygen units are available in specific locations that will be indicated during the clinic tour.
- AED unit is available on the north wall between operatories 12 and 13

To alert clinic personnel of a medical emergency, the following protocol must be followed:

You must alert & send a nearby assistant/responsible person to report the problem to the CDCA-WREB-CITA Chief. The CDCA-WREB-CITA Chief will make a judgment as to whether an emergency requiring outside help exists.

If needed assistant/responsible person will be sent to the nearest phone to activate the Emergency Medical System (EMS) by dialing 911.

As appropriate for type of emergency:

Place patient/candidate in either a sitting or supine position

Assess responsiveness

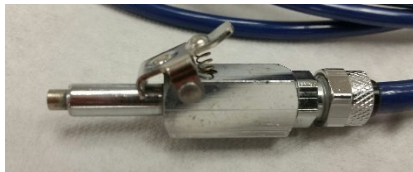
Check breathing
Check airway for blockage/aspiration
Check pulse
Be prepared to perform CPR, as indicated

During the Board

1. Sonic/Ultrasonic Devices.

- **HVE (High Volume Evacuation) is required during the entire time Ultrasonic units are in use in the DHY clinic.** PureVac suction mirror systems and shortened HVE tips are available in each operatory. All operatories are equipped with power and quick-connect air/water for use with sonic/ultrasonic devices as specified below. Ultrasonic units are NOT supplied by SLCC unless you request one ahead of time. If you are using your own Ultrasonic scaling equipment/unit: An A-dec quick disconnect plug must be on the water hose to connect to the dental unit (see picture below).

Ultrasonic inserts and handpieces must be 30K to be compatible with SLCC Cavitron® units.

- The clinic has a limited number of 30K Cavitron® units available for use during the exam at no additional charge. **Please make SLCC Caviton® unit requests with the school coordinator prior to your exam start time.*

If you are borrowing an SLCC ultrasonic unit please be aware every effort has been made to ensure SLCC “used” Ultrasonic units are in good working order; however, due to their “used” condition performance expectations may vary from unit to unit. ***Candidates are responsible for providing 30K inserts/tips and handpieces for their own use if possible.***

****A limited quantity of handpieces or insert tips are available if necessary.***

- If you wish to arrive at SLCC Jordan Campus before your scheduled testing day to hook-up your ultrasonic unit, you may do so by scheduling a time with the school coordinator by email wendee.mitchell@slcc.edu or telephone (801)957-6005. If the CDCA-WREB-CITA exam has already begun, you cannot enter the clinic to test your equipment.

2. Infection Control/Asepsis Requirements

a. Surface Asepsis

- i. Handles of the unit light, touchpads, chair/headrest, controls, suction arms etc. must be covered with either clear plastic, barriers, wrap or barrier film. (Not changed out between sessions during Simulated patient exams)

- ii. The patient chair, dental unit, counter tops, and operator stool should be disinfected with disinfectant wipes between sessions (during patient-based exams only)
- iii. Disinfectant wipes, plastic/barrier chair covers and plastic/barrier wrap are provided by SLCC Jordan Campus for all candidates free of charge.
- iv. Disposable plastic overgloves are available (free of charge) for candidates upon request.
 - v. Candidates must furnish their own sturdy utility gloves (nitrile preferred) to be worn when handling or packaging dirty instruments through (or to and from) the candidate clinic area. (Patient based exams only)
 - vi. Universal infection control guidelines and Personal Protective Equipment (P.P.E.) and guidelines should be observed during the CDCA-WREB-CITA exam at SLCC Jordan Campus. This includes standard OSHA standards and guidelines.

b. Personnel Protective Equipment

- i. Appropriate protective equipment (which includes disposable gowns) are provided/available by SLCC Jordan Campus (one per day free of charge) and must be worn in all occupational exposure situations.
- ii. Disposable gloves, masks, and gowns will be available on the clinic floor free of charge during the examinations.
- iii. Candidates must provide their own OSHA-acceptable protective glasses, shield and/or loops. (disposable side shields are available upon request)

c. Hazardous Waste

- i. Any blood/saliva soaked waste is considered hazardous and should be disposed of in the available/provided (red) biohazard bags. (Patient based exams only)
- ii. Sharps: All needles, anesthetic cartridges, and any potential sharps are to be placed in the red plastic sharps containers located throughout the SLCC Jordan Campus Dental Hygiene clinic.

Disposable Air/Water Syringe Tips and Bite Blocks

SLCC Jordan Campus provides and uses disposable air/water syringe tips for the examination. If you prefer metal air/water syringe tips you should plan accordingly and bring them to the exam with you as SLCC Jordan Campus does not provide them.

4. Translation Services

Translation services for candidates and patients are not provided by SLCC Jordan Campus. Candidates wishing to bring a translator (for languages other than English) must provide all accommodations required. All translators must check in with the CDCA-WREB-CITA desk coordinator and school coordinator upon arrival and will only be allowed into the clinical area when their services are required. Candidate translators must abide by all applicable candidate rules (no cell phones, notes, or PDA's) and safety requirements as well as all reasonable CDCA-WREB-CITA and/or SLCC Jordan Campus school coordinator requests to ensure that all other candidates have a fair, secure, quiet, safe, effective, and successful examination.

5. Other Limitations

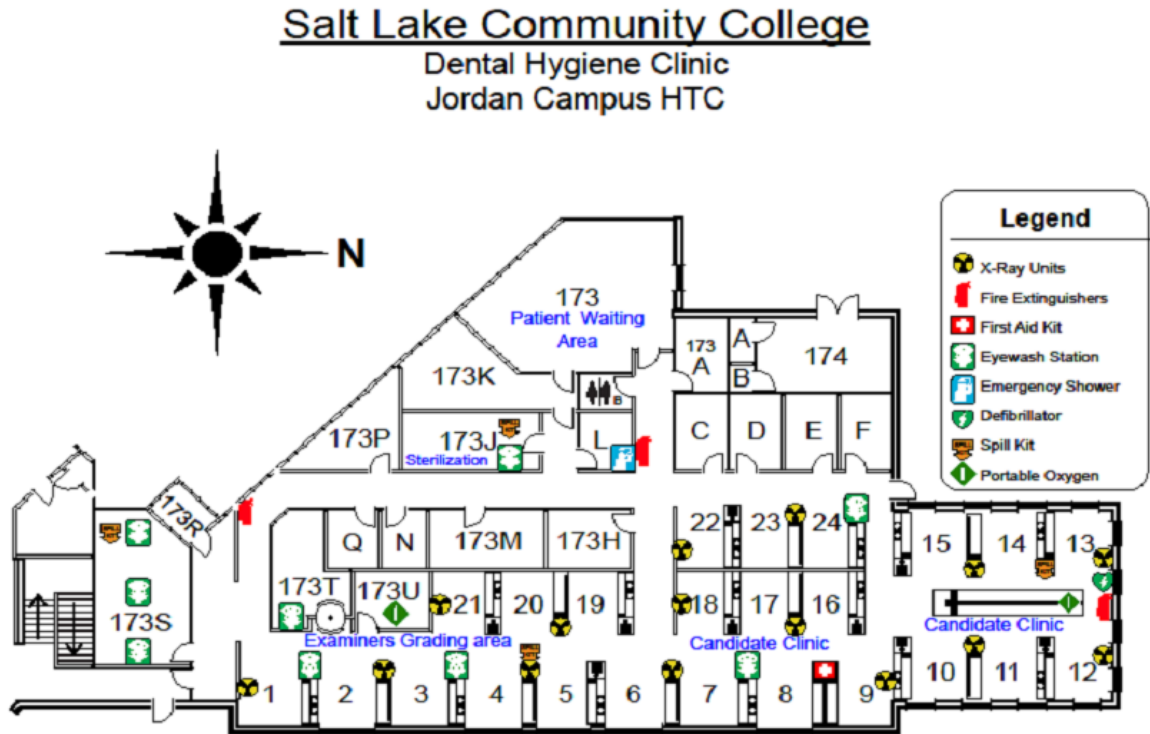
No instrument sharpening services for dental hygiene instruments are available at SLCC Jordan Campus before, during, or after the examination(s). If a candidate experiences a broken tip on one or more of their instruments during the examination SLCC Jordan Campus has a limited number of instruments available to loan, this is for broken or defective items only. As a reminder candidates and patients should not bring cell phones, notes, or PDA's to the examination. Items left behind after a candidate's exam is completed may not be returned. SLCC Jordan Campus will make every effort to remind candidates not to leave instruments and other items behind when they leave as SLCC Jordan Campus will not mail ANY items left behind. If candidates request any help from the SLCC Jordan Campus School Coordinator or staff we will be happy to help, however the candidate assumes all responsibility for any help or attempted assistance given. Inadvertent damage or perceived damage to any personal items, instruments, ultrasonics, or other items that the candidate is seeking help with is the sole responsibility of the candidate.
