ACC	Instruments, polishing cups or brushes and dental floss are effectively utilized so that no unwarranted hard tissue trauma occurs as a result of the scaling and polishing procedures.
SUB	There is <b>minor</b> hard tissue trauma that may include root surface abrasion(s) that do(es) not require additional definitive treatment.
DEF	<ul> <li>A. There is major damage to hard tissue inconsistent with the procedure.</li> <li>B. Root Surface abrasions that would require additional definitive treatment.</li> </ul>
