

# Criteria and procedures applicable to exams administered during January 1 – July 31, 2026

# 1) Prosthodontic, Endodontic & Periodontal Examinations

No changes for exams administered January 01-July 31, 2026

### 2) Restorative Examinations

- a) Exam Administration Timeline
  - Order of Exam Components updated. The Anterior Restorative procedures (3-hour) will precede the Posterior Restorative procedures (3.5-hour).
  - Each examination is timed separately.
  - All procedures must be completed within the allotted timeframe for the respective examination.

# b) Procedure Update - Indirect Pulp Cap

- Discontinuation of the Indirect Pulp Cap Process
  - Indirect Pulp Cap process and form discontinued
  - Candidates are required to remove all simulated caries

#### c) Direct Pulp Cap

- Pulp Exposure Diagnosis & Reporting
  - Candidates identify/diagnose the pulp exposure right away by submitting the form electronically before completing the preparation.
  - Misdiagnosis of pulp exposure (as well as unrecognized exposure) results in 100point penalty
- **Discontinuation of Pulp Cap Placement.** Candidates will not place the pulp cap for evaluation (preparations will be graded without a pulp cap in place and candidates may proceed to restoration after the prep has been graded.

# d) Lesion Diagnosis

- First Misdiagnosis Penalty: -15 points deducted for that procedure
- Second Misdiagnosis Penalty: -100-point penalty

#### e) Process Update

- Restorative Examination Forms & Tablet Entry
  - All official exam records will be entered electronically using the Dental Testing System (DTS)software.



- Candidate diagnosis, modification requests, notes, etc. are submitted through electronic data entry to the Evaluation Area.
- Paper forms are provided to help candidates draft their requests & notes to examiners and track their progress throughout the examination process.
- **Tablet entry instructional information** regarding the process will be included in the 2026 January-July Candidate Manual and other exam preparation resources.
